

### Vernon and Myrtle Webster Memorial Scholarship Fund

Vernon and Myrtle Webster were residents of Hardy County. They lived in Moorefield and their three children and seven grandchildren were graduates of Moorefield High School. Mr. and Mrs. Webster were supporters of Moorefield High School and were strong advocates of children having a good education.

The Vernon and Myrtle Webster Memorial Scholarship Fund in the amount of \$1000.00 has been established to be awarded annually to a graduating Moorefield High School senior.

The following guidelines will govern the administration of the Vernon and Myrtle Webster Memorial Scholarship Fund:

1. The original contribution and additional contributions to the fund shall be kept separate from other funds of the Hardy County Board of Education and shall be invested pursuant to the investment procedures established by law and the policies of the state and county boards.
2. A scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00 will be awarded annually from the interest from this fund to a graduating senior at Moorefield High School. Any year after 2011 that the fund balance exceeds \$42,000.00 an additional \$1,000.00 scholarship will be awarded at the rate of one additional scholarship for each \$1,000.00 above the \$42,000.00 balance.
3. Students wishing to be considered for a Vernon and Myrtle Webster Memorial Scholarship:
  - a. Must provide a letter of application that clearly defines the student relative to the following qualities greatly treasured by Mr. and Mrs. Webster-
    - Must be a college bound senior
    - Must have a grade point average of at least 3.0 for the four years of high school
    - Must be of good moral character
    - Must be well regarded by the faculty and the community
    - Must be involved in community and school activities
4. A selection committee composed of the Principal of Moorefield High School, the guidance counselor at Moorefield High School, and 3 teachers at Moorefield High School selected by the faculty senate will review the letters of application to verify that the applicants meet the five stated qualities.
5. The letters of application selected will be given to the Webster Family for final selection of the individual to receive the award.
6. There shall be no discrimination against students due to sex, color, race, religion, national origin, handicapping conditions or marital status.
7. The scholarship shall be paid in two equal installments payable to the institution of higher education at the beginning of the first and second semesters.
