All application materials – applications, transcript, essay, and letters of recommendation – must be received by **April 1, 2022**. All materials should be sent to McCoy's Grand Theatre Scholarship, P.O. Box 125, Moorefield, WV 26836.

The scholarship will be awarded in the form of a check, payable to the college or university the recipient is attending and is to be used as a credit toward tuition and expenses. It will be awarded as \$500.00 for the first semester and \$500.00 for the second semester. If a Letter of Acceptance is not received by August 1st of the year awarded, the scholarship may go to another qualified applicant.
