Criteria for Scholarship

4. Recipient is to be of high moral character and exercise their faith through service to others.
5. Recipient is to have participated in high school activities, sports, or clubs.
6. Recipients that are, or have been, 4H or FFA members would be preferred but not required.
7. Recipient is planning to pursue a post-secondary education.
